COLLITON CLUB

RULES ON MEMBERSHIP

The following shall be eligible for membership of the Club:

• Anyone who is aged 18 years or over is eligible for membership of the Colliton Club.

Members shall be elected at the discretion of the Board after their names have been proposed and seconded by 2 ordinary or honorary members of the Club.

The Board may, at their discretion, admit honorary members to the Club, without the payment of a subscription.

Subscriptions:

- The annual subscription for membership shall be £12, if paying by cheque or cash. Payment by standing order shall be £10 per annum.
- Members who have reached the statutory retirement age can apply for Life Membership at the following rates:

Single Membership £55

Member and Spouse £65

All annual renewals of subscriptions shall become payable on 1 January each year.

Certain local authority bodies can make monthly instalment of the annual fee on behalf of their staff and renewal is automatic. The annual fee if paid by salary deduction shall be £10.

Entrance Fees:

No general entrance fee shall be payable but the Board reserves the right to charge an entrance fee for individual special functions held within the Club's premises.

Cessation of Membership:

Should the conduct, presence or action of a member in the Club, in the opinion of any member of staff, or any Board member, be objectionable or prejudicial to the interests of the Club, the member may be required to withdraw immediately from the Club.

The member shall be informed in writing giving the reasons for the requirement of withdrawal and shall not be allowed re-entry on the Club's premises until the matter has been considered at a meeting of the Board.

The Board may consider that no further action is required and re-admit the member, or reprimand the member before re-admittance, or suspend the member until he/she has had an opportunity to appear at a hearing, before the Board. Following the hearing the member will be advised in writing of its decision that could be a suspension period, or expulsion. The decision of the Board shall be final and shall require no further explanation.

Visitors:

Members shall be allowed to introduce no more than 2 guests at one and the same time. Details should be entered in the visitor's book.

An exception to the above will be made for members of visiting teams attending the Club in connection with sporting or recreational activities. A list of visiting team members should be provided.

Guests:

Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests.

Guests should not purchase alcoholic refreshments.

Admission of persons other than Members and Guests:

Persons other than members or guests may be admitted for the purpose of attending functions. Alcohol can be purchased by them for consumption on the premises.
